

JOURNEY AT CAESARS

One of the most popular rock bands of all time, Journey takes over the Strip this fall with a limited engagement residency inside The Colosseum at Caesars Palace. The band behind "Don't Stop Believin'" (the top-selling digital track in history) was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2017, honoring 19 top-40 singles and 25 gold and platinum albums since the group's formation in 1973 in San Francisco. FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS

For the sixth year, the largest lantern festival in the world returns to the Mojave Desert, just 25 miles south of Vegas. More than 25,000 guests will gather in this untouched landscape over the weekend of October 4 to take part in a breathtaking simultaneous paper sky lantern release (all lanterns are 100% biodegradable and recovered from the surrounding desert after the event). A dozen local food trucks will be on-site serving refreshments, accompanied by live music.
