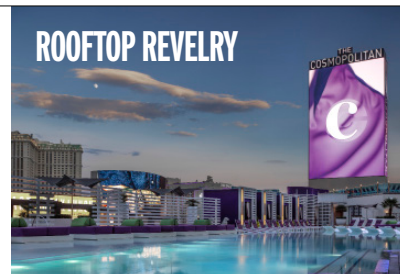

ROOFTOP REVELRY



The Cosmopolitan's iconic rooftop pool district is back with a myriad of exciting experiences this summer to celebrate the resort's ten-year anniversary. Thursdays through mid-September, the North Bar patio hosts sunset cocktail hour with upbeat live music and a summer spritz cart by Campari. CAVIAR DEVILLE

Caviar tacos and captivating cocktail pairings take center stage at Petrossian Bar's new epicurean experience at Bellagio Resort & Casino. The iconic people-watching destination has a brand new menu, including standouts like a Bellagio martini poured over a spherical ice cube and paired with a lavish ossetra caviar cigar. The imaginative caviar creations include a savory caviar pie layered with crème fraiche, brown butter, and green apples, and even extend to dessert with dark chocolate caviar pearls presented with rosé champagne sorbet, vanilla chantilly, and lemon gelée. MEAT AND GREET

Celebrity chef and restaurateur David Chang (host of the travelogue *Ugly Delicious* on Netflix) debuted his casual seafood and steakhouse Majordomo Meat & Fish in the Palazzo tower of the Venetian Resort in late 2019, and the sizzling concept continues to add new elements. The restaurant specializes in smoked meats, fresh sea favorites, a raw bar, and creative drinks, including his signature smoked prime rib, a dry-aged Creekstone beef that's cured for 24 hours in seasoned salt. In true Vegas fashion, dining here is a spectacle, with custom trolleys and tableside preparations bringing the magic of the kitchen into the dining room. There's also a secret karaoke room for larger parties, replete with its own private dining room, restroom, and lounge.
